24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 15-4-1602(5) is amended to read as follows:

27 (5) "Di stri bution center" means a facility for the reception, storage,
28 or shi ppi ng;

29 (A) ~~of~~ Of a business' own products or products which the
30 business wholesales to retail businesses or ships to its own retail outlets;
31 or

32 (B) Of products owned by other companies with which the business
33 has contracts for storage and shipping if seventy-five percent (75%) of the
34 sales revenues are from out-of-state customers; or

35 (C) Of products for sale to the general public if seventy-five
36 percent (75%) of the sales revenues are from out-of-state customers;

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 15-4-1602(9) is amended to read as follows:

(9) "High unemployment" means an unemployment rate equal to or in excess of ten percent (10%) or more than three percent (3%) above one hundred fifty percent (150%) of the state's average unemployment rate for the preceding calendar year as specified by statewide annual labor force statistics compiled by the Arkansas Employment Security Department, when the state's annual average unemployment rate is six percent (6%) or below. When the state's annual average unemployment rate is above six percent (6%), "high unemployment" means equal to or in excess of three percent (3%) above the state's average unemployment rate for the preceding calendar year as specified by statewide annual labor force statistics compiled by the Arkansas Employment Security Department;

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 15-4-1602(11) is amended to read as follows:

(11) "Office sector ~~business~~" means control centers that influence the environment in which data processing, customer service, credit accounting, telemarketing, claims processing, and other administrative functions that act as production centers are performed.

SECTION 4. Arkansas Code 15-4-1605(1)(B)(ii) is amended to read as follows:

(ii) All businesses in this group must employ twenty-five (25) or more net new full-time permanent employees, derive at least ~~sixty percent (60%)~~ seventy-five percent (75%) of their revenue from out-of-state sales, and have no retail sales to the general public;

SECTION 5. Arkansas Code 15-4-1605(1)(D)(ii) is amended to read as follows:

(ii) All businesses in this group must derive at least ~~sixty percent (60%)~~ seventy-five percent (75%) of their revenue from out-of-state sales, and have no retail sales to the general public;

SECTION 6. Arkansas Code 15-4-1605(1)(E) is amended to read as follows:

(E) A distribution center with no retail sales to the general public,

1 unless seventy-five percent (75%) of the sales revenues are from out-of-state
2 customers, and which will employ one hundred (100) or more net new full-time
3 permanent employees;
