19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-37-207 is amended to read as follows:

22 5-37-207. Fraudulent use of a credit card or debit card.

23 (a) A person commits the offense of fraudulent use of a credit card or  
24 debit card if, with purpose to defraud, he uses a credit card, ~~or~~ credit card  
25 account number, debit card or debit card account number to obtain property or  
26 services with knowledge that:

27 (1) The card or account number is stolen; or

28 (2) The card or account number has been revoked or cancelled; or

29 (3) The card or account number is forged; or

30 (4) For any other reason his use of the card or account number  
31 is unauthorized by either the issuer or the person to whom the credit card or  
32 debit card is issued.

33 (b) Fraudulent use of a credit card or debit card is a Class C felony if the  
34 value of all money, goods, or services obtained during any six-month period  
35 exceeds one hundred dollars (\$100). Otherwise, it is a Class A misdemeanor.
