14 AN ACT TO PREVENT THE DISCLOSURE OF

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
19

20 SECTION 1. No person or other entity who maintains genetic information
21 shall be compelled to disclose such information pursuant to a request for
22 compulsory disclosure in any judicial, legislative, or administrative
23 proceeding, unless:

24 (1) The request for compulsory disclosure is in accordance with
25 court-ordered paternity testing in a civil action to determine paternity;

26 (2) The individual whose genetic information is requested is a
27 party to the proceeding and the genetic information is at issue;

28 (3) The genetic information is for use in a law enforcement
29 investigation or criminal trial; or

30 (4) The genetic information is for use in a law enforcement
31 investigation where an insurer is reporting fraud or criminal activity.
