20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 6-17-111(a), pertaining to the duty-  
23 free lunch period for teachers, is amended to read as follows:

24 (a) (1) For a minimum of eighty percent (80%) of the student contact  
25 days, each school district in this state shall provide at least a thirty-  
26 minute uninterrupted duty-free lunch period for each certified school  
27 employee in its employment.

28 (2) Any teacher not receiving a duty-free lunch for a minimum of  
29 eighty percent (80%) of the student contact days shall receive an hourly per  
30 diem rate for each missed lunch period unless the teacher waives his or her  
31 right to be compensated.
