18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
19

20 SECTION 1. (a)(1) Citizens band radio equipment shall not be used
21 unless that equipment is certified by the Federal Communications Commission.

22 (2) Citizens band radio equipment shall not be operated on a
23 frequency between twenty-four (24) Megahertz and thirty-five (35) Megahertz
24 without authorization from the Federal Communications Commission.

25 (b) Nothing in this act shall be construed to affect any radio station
26 that is licensed by the Federal Communication Commission under 47 U.S.C. 301.

27 (c)(1) A first violation of this act is a violation, and punishable by
28 a fine of one hundred dollars (\$100).

29 (2) A second or subsequent violation of this act is a
30 misdemeanor, and punishable by a fine not to exceed one thousand dollars
31 (\$1,000).
