12 AN ACT CONCERNING KINSHIP CARE.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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18 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 9-28-502 is amended to read as follows:  
19 9-28-502. Definitions.

20 As used in this subchapter:

21 (1) "Division" means the Division of Children and Family Services in  
22 the Department of Human Services; ~~and~~

23 (2) "Foster parent" means any person with whom a child in the ~~care,~~  
24 ~~custody, or guardianship~~ of the division is placed for temporary or long-term  
25 care, but shall not include any persons with whom a child is placed for the  
26 purpose of adoption; ~~and~~

27 (3) "Kinship foster parent" means any relative within the first,  
28 second, or third degree of consanguinity to the parent or stepparent of a  
29 child who is:

30 (A) Related through blood or marriage; and

31 (B) Approved to be a foster parent to a child who is in the  
32 custody of the department.  
33

34 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 9-28-503 is amended to read as follows:  
35 9-28-503. Powers and duties of division - Eligibility standards.

36 (a)(1) When a child has been removed from his home and is in the ~~care,~~

1 custody, or guardianship of the division, the division shall attempt to place  
2 the child with a relative for kinship foster care.

3 (2) ~~The division shall establish, in accordance with the~~  
4 ~~provisions of this subchapter, eligibility standards for becoming a kinship~~  
5 ~~foster parent~~ Kinship foster parents shall meet standards and requirements  
6 established by the division for all foster parents, including, but not limited  
7 to:

- 8 (A) Training;
- 9 (B) Background checks; and
- 10 (C) Home study requirements.

11 ~~(b)(1) A person shall be eligible to become a kinship foster parent~~  
12 ~~only upon the completion of an investigation to ascertain if there is a state~~  
13 ~~or federal record of criminal history for the prospective kinship foster~~  
14 ~~parent or any other adult residing in the prospective parent's home.~~

15 ~~(2) The Arkansas Crime Information Center shall conduct the~~  
16 ~~investigation and shall make the results of the investigation available to the~~  
17 ~~division in accordance with § 12-12-211.~~

18 ~~(3) The division shall maintain the confidentiality of the~~  
19 ~~investigation results and shall use the results only for purposes of~~  
20 ~~determining a person's eligibility to become a kinship foster parent.~~

21 ~~(4) It shall be unlawful, except for the purpose of determining a~~  
22 ~~person's eligibility for kinship foster care, for any person to disclose~~  
23 ~~information obtained under this subsection.~~

24 ~~(5) Any person violating this subsection shall be guilty of a~~  
25 ~~Class A misdemeanor.~~

26 ~~(c)(1) Relatives within the first, second, or third degree to the~~  
27 ~~parent or stepparent of a child who may be related through blood or marriage~~  
28 ~~may be eligible for approval as a kinship foster parent.~~

29 ~~(2) The kinship foster parent shall be twenty one (21) years of~~  
30 ~~age or older, except that, if the spouse or partner of the relative is twenty-~~  
31 ~~one (21) years of age or older and living in the home, and the relative is~~  
32 ~~between eighteen (18) and twenty one (21) years of age, the division may waive~~  
33 ~~the age requirement.~~

34 ~~(d) The division shall determine whether the person is able to care~~
