20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21

22 SECTION 1. (a) For purposes of this act, "cabins and cottages", means
23 corporations, partnerships, individuals, limited liability corporations, and
24 other legal entities whose primary function is to provide overnight
25 accommodations to the public, not exceeding a total of twenty (20) guest
26 rooms on the premises, whether operated by the business owner or not.

27 (b) Cabins and cottages are authorized to give a complimentary bottle
28 of wine to their guests.
