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25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27 SECTION 1. (a) The Department of Education shall develop specific
28 criteria, based on generally accepted statistical procedures, for evaluating
29 the association of high school grade point averages and standardized test
30 scores for all students participating in the American College Test and the
31 Arkansas Comprehensive Testing Assessment and Accountability Program's end-
32 of-course algebra, geometry and literacy exams.

33 (b) Any school identified by the Department of Education as having
34 statistically significant variance between grade point average and students
35 performance on the aforementioned exams shall be notified in writing no later
36 than thirty (30) calendar days after the determination.
