4	If any horse, cattle, or other stock shall break into any enclosure, the		
5	fence being of the height and sufficiency required by this chapter, or if any		
6	hog, pig, or shoat shall break into it, the owner of the creature shall:		
7	(1) For the first trespass, make reparation to the party injured for		
8	the true value of the damages he may have sustained;		
9	(2) For every trespass thereafter, double damages to be recovered with		
10	costs, before any justice of the peace or court having jurisdiction thereof,		
11	in the name of the injured party; and		
12	(3) For the third offense from any of the animals named breaking into		
13	the enclosure, the party injured may kill and destroy the animals so		
14	trespassing without being answerable for it.
