19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. (a) No child may be home schooled if any person residing in
22 the home with the child is required to register under Title 12, Chapter 12,
23 Subchapter 9 of the Arkansas Code.

24 (b) Upon petition to the sentencing court from the child's parent
25 or guardian, the sentencing court may enter a written order specifically
26 waiving the restriction in subsection (a).

27 (c) This section shall not apply if the child to be home schooled is
28 the person registered under Title 12, Chapter 12, Subchapter 9 of the Arkansas
29 Code.
