9 AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 24-11-415  
10 CONCERNING PROCEEDS DERIVED FROM THE SALE OF  
11 CONFISCATED GOODS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

13 TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 24-11-415  
14 CONCERNING PROCEEDS DERIVED FROM THE  
15 SALE OF CONFISCATED GOODS.  
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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 24-11-415 is amended to read as follows:  
22 24-11-415. Proceeds derived from sale of confiscated goods.

23 (a)(1) In all cities and towns, the proceeds derived from the sale of  
24 all confiscated goods which are required by the laws of this state to be sold  
25 if they were confiscated by a police officer of the city, or by the sheriff  
26 or Arkansas State Police within the city, shall be deposited in the city's  
27 policemen's pension and retirement fund.

28 (2) Subdivision (a)(1) shall not supercede any existing  
29 provisions of law governing the disposition of confiscated goods.

30 (b)(1) In all cities and towns, until a time as the pension and  
31 retirement fund is actuarially sound as determined by the actuary under  
32 contract with the Arkansas Fire and Police Pension Review Board, all monies  
33 confiscated by a police officer of the city, or by the sheriff or Arkansas  
34 State Police within the city, shall be deposited in the city's policemen's  
35 pension and retirement fund.

36 (2) Subdivision (b)(1) shall not supercede any existing

1 provisions of law governing the disposition of confiscated monies.

2 (3) At the time that the pension and retirement fund is  
3 actuarially sound, all monies received under this subdivision (b) shall be  
4 retained by the city.
