9 AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 17-82-302 TO EXEMPT FROM
10 THE ARKANSAS DENTAL PRACTICE ACT A PERSON PRACTICING
11 DENTISTRY OR DENTAL HYGIENE AS AN EMPLOYEE OF THE
12 FEDERAL BUREAU OF PRISONS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 17-82-302 is amended to read as follows:
25 17-82-302. Exemptions.

26 Nothing in this chapter shall prohibit or require a license for the
27 following acts or practices:

28 (1) The performance of duty in this state of a commissioned dental or
29 medical officer of the United States Army, Air Force, Navy, federal Department
30 of Veterans Affairs, or Public Health Services;

31 (2) Clinical demonstrations before a society or convention of dentists
32 or dental hygienists by a duly licensed dentist or dental hygienist of another
33 state, territory, or the District of Columbia;

34 (3) Acts which would otherwise constitute the practice of dentistry or
35 dental hygiene by students under the supervision of instructors in any dental
36 college, university, hospital or institution, or dental department of any

1 college, university, hospital or institution, or school of dental hygiene in
 2 this state which is recognized as being reputable by the American Dental
 3 Association Council on Dental Education and approved by the board. Such acts
 4 must be performed within the educational facility incident to a course of
 5 study or training and shall not be carried on for personal profit;

6 (4) Acts which would otherwise constitute the practice of dentistry by
 7 a graduate of a college of dentistry approved by the board who is engaged in
 8 an internship or residency program in a dental college, university, hospital
 9 or institution, or dental department of any college, university, hospital or
 10 institution in this state which is recognized as being reputable by the
 11 American Dental Association Council on Dental Education and approved by the
 12 board. Such acts must be performed within the facility pursuant to such
 13 internship or residency program, and the intern or resident shall serve
 14 without fee or compensation other than that received in salary or other
 15 authorized allowances; ~~or~~

16 (5) Acts which would otherwise constitute the practice of dentistry by
 17 a graduate of a college of dentistry approved by the board who is engaged in
 18 teaching dentistry in a dental college, university, hospital or institution,
 19 or dental department of any college, university, hospital or institution in
 20 this state which is recognized as being reputable by the American Dental
 21 Association Council on Dental Education and approved by the board. Such acts
 22 must be performed within the facility pursuant to the teaching appointment,
 23 and the person shall serve without fee or compensation other than that
 24 received in salary or other authorized allowances; ~~or~~ or

25 (6)(A) The practice of dentistry or dental hygiene within the scope of
 26 the dentist's or dental hygienist's duties as an employee of the Federal
 27 Bureau of Prisons, provided the dentist or dental hygienist has obtained a
 28 license to practice from Arkansas or any other state, territory, the District
 29 of Columbia, or Canada.

30 (B) Dentists and dental hygienists authorized to practice
 31 under subdivision (6)(A) of this section may provide dental treatment or
 32 services only to inmates and shall not provide dental treatment or services to
 33 other employees of the Federal Bureau of Prisons or any other person.
