18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
19

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 19-5-1206 (b) is amended to read:

21 (b)(1) This fund shall consist of funds transferred to it from the
22 *General Improvement Fund or other funds, gifts, bequests, foundation grants*
23 *and gifts, Governor's or other emergency funds, federal grants and matching*
24 *funds, short-term loans and advances, proceeds from bond issues, leases,*
25 *service charges or fees, interagency transfers of funds, partnerships and*
26 *debentures, and other funds as may be appropriated by the General Assembly.*

27 (2) The fund shall be used to acquire, either by deed or by lease,
28 own and operate, maintain, repair, and renovate, develop, or construct real
29 properties, including any necessary demolition and site improvements, for use
30 by state agencies, as defined at § 22-2-101. for capital improvement needs
31 under the jurisdiction of Arkansas State Building Services.

33 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
34 General Assembly of Arkansas, that changes in the state's fiscal laws must
35 take effect at the beginning of the fiscal year and that if the current
36 legislative session is so extended that the ninety-day period is later than

1 July 1, 2001 such changes will not be timely. Therefore an emergency is
2 declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the
3 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective
4 July 1, 2001.
