19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 18-46-102(8), concerning the definition of
23 practitioner in the Medical, Nursing, Hospital, and Ambulance Service Lien
24 Act, is amended to read as follows:

25 (8) "Practitioner" means a person licensed to treat human ailments
26 under the provisions of § 17-95-202 et seq. and includes the practice of
27 dentistry as defined in § 17-82-102 and a person licensed to practice
28 chiropractic under the provisions of § 17-81-101 et seq., and a person
29 licensed to practice massage therapy under the Massage Therapy Act;
