14 TO REQUIRE COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTION
15 COMMISSIONERS TO POST SIGNS NEAR THE
16 DRIVEWAY ENTRANCES OF POLLING SITES TO
17 GIVE NOTICE OF THE POLLING SITE.
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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 7-4-107(b) is amended to read as follows:

24 (b)(1)(A) It shall be the duty of the county board to select and
25 appoint a sufficient number of election officials for each polling site as
26 provided by subsection (a) of this section and to perform the other duties
27 prescribed not fewer than twenty (20) days preceding an election.

28 (B) Each polling site shall have a minimum of two (2)
29 election clerks, one (1) election judge, and one (1) election sheriff. The
30 minority party election commissioner shall have the option to designate a
31 number of election officials equal to one (1) fewer than the majority of
32 election officials at each polling site, with a minimum of two (2) election
33 officials at each polling site. In the event that the county party
34 representatives on the county board fail to agree upon any election official
35 to fill any election post allotted to the respective party twenty (20) days
36 before the election, then, and in that event, the county board shall appoint

1 the remaining election officials.

2 (2) Within fifteen (15) days prior to the election, the county
3 board shall prepare, publish, and post in a public place in the county
4 sheriff's office and in the county clerk's office of each county their lists
5 of appointees of election officials.

6 (3)(A) On the day of a general, special, or runoff election, the
7 election sheriff shall post a double-sided sign that is at least two feet by
8 two feet (2' X 2') in size near each main driveway entrance to the polling
9 site on each public street bordering the polling site.

10 (B) Each sign shall:

11 (i) State "VOTE HERE" at each polling site;

12 (ii) Contain an arrow pointing to the polling site;

13 (iii) Be placed as close as possible to the public
14 street without obstructing traffic; and

15 (iv) Be visible to all traffic approaching the
16 polling site.
