9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF
10 FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER FOR
11 STATE SUPPORT FOR FIRE DEPARTMENTS IN GRANT COUNTY;
12 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

14 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
15 ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER -
16 FIRE DEPARTMENTS GRANT COUNTY CAPITAL
17 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATION.
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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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24 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS - FIRE DEPARTMENTS IN GRANT COUNTY. There is
25 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration -
26 Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
27 successor fund or fund accounts, the following:

28 (A) For state support for the Belfast/Palestine Volunteer Fire Department,
29 the sum of \$5,000.

30 (B) For state support for the Calvert Township Volunteer Fire Department,
31 the sum of \$5,000.

32 (C) For state support for the Cane Creek Volunteer Fire Department, the sum
33 of \$5,000.

34 (D) For state support for the Center Grove Volunteer Fire Department, the
35 sum of \$5,000.

36 (E) For state support for the Grapevine Fire Department, the sum of

- 1 \$5,000.
- 2 (F) For state support for the Leola Fire Department, the sum of
- 3 \$5,000.
- 4 (G) For state support for the Lono-Rolla Volunteer Fire Department, Inc.,
- 5 the sum of \$5,000.
- 6 (H) For state support for the Poyen Fire Department, the sum of
- 7 \$5,000.
- 8 (I) For state support for the Prattsville Volunteer Fire Department, the
- 9 sum of \$5,000.
- 10 (J) For state support for the Sheridan Fire Department, the sum of
- 11 \$5,000.
- 12 (K) For state support for the Tull Fire Department, the sum of \$5,000.

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14 SECTION 2. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor

15 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects

16 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available

17 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and

18 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and

19 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or

20 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State

21 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects

22 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds

23 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General

24 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall

25 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

26 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing

27 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue

28 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State

29 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,

30 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any

31 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

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33 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly

34 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained

35 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act

36 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations

1 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
2 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
3 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
4 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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6 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
7 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
8 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
9 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the
10 agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the
11 event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date
12 of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper
13 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an
14 emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
15 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
16 force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.
