14 AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE
15 ARKANSAS COMMEMORATIVE COMMISSION TO THE
16 OLD STATE HOUSE COMMISSION.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. (a) The Arkansas Commemorative Commission shall hereafter
23 be known as the "Old State House Commission".

24 (b) The Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall make appropriate
25 changes to sections of the Arkansas Code to substitute the "Old State House
26 Commission" for the "Arkansas Commemorative Commission".

27 (c) This section is not required to be codified by the Arkansas Code
28 Revision Commission.
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30 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 15-20-410 is amended to read as follows:

31 15-20-410. Easements held by ~~Arkansas Commemorative Commission~~ Old State
32 House Commission.

33 (a)(1) Approval of the creation, modification, or termination of a
34 conservation easement held by the ~~Arkansas Commemorative Commission~~ Old State
35 House Commission shall be executed by the Director of the ~~Arkansas~~
36 ~~Commemorative Commission~~ Old State House Commission in accordance with the

1 rules and regulations promulgated by the ~~Arkansas Commemorative Commission~~ Old
2 State House Commission to assure that conservation easements shall be in the
3 public interest.

4 (2) Approval shall be evidenced by a certificate of approval,
5 certificate of modification, or certificate of termination duly executed on
6 behalf of the ~~Arkansas Commemorative Commission~~ Old State House Commission and
7 duly recorded in the deed records of the county in which the real property is
8 located.

9 (b) In determining whether the conservation easement or its continuance
10 is in the public interest, the ~~Arkansas Commemorative Commission~~ Old State
11 House Commission shall take into consideration any national, state, regional,
12 and local comprehensive land use or development plan affecting the historical,
13 architectural, archeological, or cultural aspects of the real property.

14 (c) A conservation easement held by the commission may be modified or
15 released, in whole or in part, by the commission for such consideration, if
16 any, as the commission may determine, in the same manner as the commission may
17 dispose of land or other interests in land, but only after a public hearing
18 upon reasonable public notice under such procedures established by the
19 commission.

20 (d) All easements in the name of the Arkansas Commemorative Commission
21 are transferred to the Old State House Commission.
