14 AN ACT TO ENSURE THAT ENTITIES WHICH ARE
15 REQUIRED TO DISPLAY SIGNS FOR THE
16 DISABLED SHALL DISPLAY THE BLUE AND
17 WHITE INTERNATIONAL SYMBOL OF ACCESS.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. (a) State agencies which require any persons, agencies,
24 boards, commissions, businesses or other entities to display signs for the
25 disabled shall require those persons, agencies, boards, commissions,
26 businesses or other entities to display only the blue and white international
27 symbol of access.

28 (b) This act shall have no retroactive effect, applying only to signs
29 installed subsequent to this act taking effect.

30 (c) This act shall apply only if installation of a required sign can
31 be achieved without creating a negative financial impact on any persons,
32 agencies, boards, commissions, businesses or other entities required to
33 display signs for the disabled.
