21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 21-1-402 is amended by adding an additional
24 subsection to read as follows:

25 (f) A former member of the Arkansas Senate or the Arkansas House of
26 Representatives shall not be eligible to be registered as a lobbyist under
27 Arkansas Code §§ 21-8-601 through 21-8-607 until the expiration of the term
28 of office for which he or she was elected.
