18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
19

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-38-302 is amended to read as follows:  
21 17-38-302. Exemptions.

22 The licensing provisions of this chapter shall not apply to:

23 (1) Plumbing work done by a property owner in a building owned  
24 and occupied by him or her as his or her home, except where the license is  
25 required by local ordinance; ~~or~~

26 (2) Work done on buildings whose primary use is agricultural  
27 located outside the incorporated limits of any city or town, unless the  
28 buildings are connected to a public water system, sewerage system, or gas  
29 utility system; or

30 (3) Individuals certifying or repairing backflow devices within  
31 the scope of a plumbing system, if the individuals hold a certificate of  
32 competency from the Department of Health, Committee of Plumbing Examiners.
