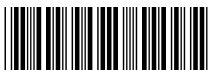

16 AN ACT FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF CENTRAL  
17 ARKANSAS APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2003-2005  
18 BIENNIUM.  
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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
23

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for  
25 the University of Central Arkansas for the 2003-2005 biennium, the following  
26 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the  
27 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code  
28 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
29 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual  
30 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of  
31 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying  
32 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the  
33 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),  
34 or its successor.

 26 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FOOD  
 28 SERVICE. If the University of Central Arkansas cancels the current contract  
 29 for food service and chooses to operate the food service with University  
 30 employees, the President, upon authorization of the Board of Trustees, is  
 31 allowed to utilize the contingent positions contained in Section 1 of this  
 32 Act, provided he or she has obtained approval from the Department of Higher  
 33 Education and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, who has sought prior  
 34 review by the Arkansas Legislative Council.

35 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from ~~July 1, 2001~~  
 36 July 1, 2003 through ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

2 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
3 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL  
4 ALLOWANCE. The Board of Trustees of the University of Central Arkansas may  
5 make special allowances available to any coach who coaches more than one  
6 sport in an amount not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) per year for  
7 any one coach during each year of the ~~2001-2003~~ 2003-2005 biennium. Further,  
8 the Board of Trustees of the University of Central Arkansas is hereby  
9 authorized to make additional payments to head coaches at the University of  
10 Central Arkansas from revenues generated by contracts with vendors of  
11 athletic apparel, shoes and other products in such amounts as may be  
12 established by the Board of Trustees for performance by the coaches of  
13 consulting and other obligations pursuant to contracts between the University  
14 and such vendors. Such additional payments to head coaches shall not be  
15 considered salary and shall not be deemed or construed to exceed the maximum  
16 salaries established for such coaches by the Act. Nothing in this section  
17 shall be construed to reduce or eliminate the authority granted elsewhere in  
18 Arkansas statutes for the payment of allowances or bonuses to coaches at the  
19 University of Central Arkansas. Further, if the special allowance funds  
20 authorized herein are utilized, the University of Central Arkansas shall  
21 report annually to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee the exact  
22 disposition of those special allowance funds.

23 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from ~~July 1, 2001~~  
24 July 1, 2003 through ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

26 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

28 STORE. If the University of Central Arkansas cancels the current contract for  
29 operation of its book store and chooses to operate its book store with  
30 University employees, the President, upon authorization of the Board of  
31 Trustees, is allowed to utilize the contingent positions contained in Section  
32 1 of this Act, provided he or she has obtained approval from the Department  
33 of Higher Education and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, who has sought  
34 prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council.

35 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from ~~July 1, 2001~~  
36 July 1, 2003 through ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

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SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ON-CALL PAY. All Classified Positions employed in areas providing critical or emergency support for the operations of the University of Central Arkansas and required to work outside their normal work schedule shall be eligible for on-call status and eligible to receive stand-by pay not to exceed four hours of work per shift. When standby pay is provided to employees as herein described, the total compensation may exceed the line item salaries for those positions as included in this Act.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2005.

SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MEMBERSHIP AUTHORIZATION. The Board of Trustees of the University of Central Arkansas is hereby authorized to enact voluntary payroll deductions for employees using on-campus programs and facilities. All such deductions shall be entirely voluntary in nature, shall require written authorization from each participant electing to use such deductions and shall not be made on a pre-tax basis. Nothing in this section shall be construed to reduce or eliminate the payroll regulations established elsewhere in Arkansas Statutes.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2005.

SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due. This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the President or Chancellor will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or upon

1 release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief Fiscal  
2 Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the Board  
3 approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal year.

4 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003  
5 through June 30, 2005.

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7 SECTION 12. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
8 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
9 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
10 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
11 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
12 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures  
13 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this  
14 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
15 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
16 with in disbursement of said funds.

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18 SECTION 13. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
19 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
20 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
21 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
22 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
23 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
24 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
25 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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27 SECTION 14. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
28 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
29 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
30 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of  
31 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
32 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
33 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the  
34 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
35 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
36 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and

1 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
