(2) All voter registration information obtained by any local 18 19 election official in the state shall be electronically entered into the 20 computerized list on an expedited basis at the time the information is 21 provided to the local official. 22 (3) The Secretary of State shall provide the support as may be 23 required so that local election officials are able to enter the information. 24 25 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 26 Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the federal Help America Vote Act 27 establishes deadlines for the state's compliance with the act's voter 28 registration requirements; and that the immediate passage of this act is 29 necessary to ensure the state meets its deadlines. Therefore, an emergency 30 is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective 31 32 on: 33 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor; 34 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, 35 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the 36 bill; or
