26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

28 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 18, Subchapter 2 is amended

29 to add an additional section to read as follows:

30 6-18-228. Attending classes and programs not offered by an assigned

31 school.

32 Any student that is enrolled in a public school in a school district

33 that is administratively consolidated by Act 60 of the Second Extraordinary

34 Session of 2003 may, at the discretion of the local school board of

35 directors, be eligible to attend any class, academic program, or participate

36 in any extracurricular activity or program offered by another school in the



1 administratively consolidated district, if *the public school* to which the
2 student is assigned to attend does not offer the same or similar class,
3 academic program, or extracurricular activity or program.
