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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 9-28-301(b)-(d), concerning inspections of
22 youth services facilities, are amended to read as follows:

23 (b)(1) Inspections shall include, but shall not be limited to, ~~those~~
24 ~~inspections provided for in the current Standards for Juvenile Training~~
25 ~~Schools published by the American Correction Association in cooperation with~~
26 ~~the Commission on Accreditation for Corrections,~~ compliance with:

27 (A) Rules pertaining to general sanitation;

28 (B) Rules pertaining to retail food establishments;

29 (C) The Arkansas Mechanical Code of the Department of
30 Health;

31 (D) The Arkansas Plumbing and Natural Gas Codes of the
32 Department of Health;

33 (E) Rules of the Arkansas State Board of Pharmacy; and

34 (F) Rules pertaining to controlled substances.

35 (2) If the youth services facility is not accredited by the



1 Commission on Accreditation for Corrections, the inspection shall also
2 include compliance with the health and safety standards contained in the
3 applicable American Correctional Association Standards manual, as in effect
4 on January 1, 2005.

5 (c) *The inspections, while random, shall be performed at least two (2)*
6 *times per calendar year with specific follow-up inspections by the Department*
7 *of Health to monitor deficiencies and corrections as determined by the*
8 *Department of Health.*

9 (d) The Department of Human Services shall adopt the ~~current Standards~~
10 ~~for Juvenile Training Schools~~ standards as in effect on January 1, 2005,
11 published by the American ~~Correction~~ Correctional Association in cooperation
12 with the Commission on Accreditation for Corrections as it relates to health
13 concerns.
