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24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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26 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-6-203(a) and (b), resulting from*
27 *Initiated Act 1 of 1990 and Initiated Act 1 of 1996, is amended to read as*
28 *follows:*

29 *(a)(1)(A) It shall be unlawful for any candidate for any public*
30 *office, except the office of Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of*
31 *State, Treasurer of State, Auditor of State, Attorney General, and*
32 *Commissioner of State Lands, or for any person acting on the candidate's*
33 *behalf to accept campaign contributions in excess of ~~one thousand dollars~~*
34 *~~(\$1,000)~~ two thousand dollars (\$2,000) per election from any person.*

35 *(B) A candidate may accept a campaign contribution or*



1 contributions up to the maximum amount from any prospective contributor for
2 each election, whether opposed or unopposed.

3 (2)(A) It shall be unlawful for any candidate for the office of
4 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, Treasurer of State,
5 Auditor of State, Attorney General, and Commissioner of State Lands or for
6 any person acting on the candidate's behalf to accept campaign contributions
7 in excess of ~~one thousand dollars (\$1,000)~~ two thousand dollars (\$2,000) per
8 election from any person.

9 (B) A candidate may accept a campaign contribution or
10 contributions up to the maximum amount from any prospective contributor for
11 each election, whether opposed or unopposed.

12 (b)(1)(A) It shall be unlawful for any person to make a contribution
13 to a candidate for any public office, except the office of Governor,
14 Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, Treasurer of State, Auditor of
15 State, Attorney General, and Commissioner of State Lands, or to any person
16 acting on the candidate's behalf which in the aggregate exceeds ~~one thousand~~

25 behalf which in the aggregate exceeds ~~one thousand dollars (\$1,000)~~ two
26 thousand dollars (\$2,000) per election.

27 (B) A person may make a contribution or contributions up
28 to the maximum amount to a candidate for each election, whether opposed or
29 unopposed.
