22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 6-13-629. Training and instruction - Reimbursement.

25 (a)(1)(A) All members of a local school district board of directors
26 who have served on the board for twelve (12) or more consecutive months
27 ~~electd at each annual school election shall receive a minimum of~~ shall
28 obtain no less than six (6) hours of training and instruction by December 31
29 of each calendar year ~~in the school laws of this state and in the laws~~
30 ~~governing the powers, duties, and responsibilities of school boards.~~

31 (B) All members of a school district board of directors
32 electd for an initial or non-continuous term shall obtain no less than nine
33 (9) hours of training and instruction by December 31 of the calendar year
34 following the year in which they were electd.

35 (2) The training and instruction required under this section



1 shall include topics relevant to school laws, school operations, and the
2 powers, duties, and responsibilities of the members of the board of
3 directors, including, but not limited to, legal requirements, role
4 differentiation, financial management, and improving student achievement.

5 (3) Hours of training and instruction obtained in excess of the
6 minimum requirements each year may accumulate and be carried forward from
7 year to year.

8 ~~(2)~~(4) This instruction may be received from an institution of
9 higher learning in this state, from instruction sponsored or approved by the
10 Department of Education, or by an in-service training program conducted by or
11 through the Arkansas School Boards Association.

12 ~~(3)~~(5) ~~Any school board member completing a course of~~
13 ~~instruction shall receive a certification of completion, and a copy shall be~~
14 ~~entered into the minutes of the local school board on which he or she serves.~~
15 A school district shall maintain a record of hours of training and
16 instruction for board members, which may be in the form of an attested,
17 cumulative annual report from the training providers and which shall be
18 subject to verification and inspection during the school district's annual
19 audit.

20 ~~(4)~~ Upon having completed the course of instruction meeting the
21 ~~minimum requirements of this section, it shall not be necessary for a school~~
22 ~~board member to take an additional course of instruction upon being reelected~~
23 ~~to the school board.~~

24 (b) Local school district boards of directors are authorized to pay
25 per diem and other necessary expenses from funds belonging to the school
26 district and to reimburse school board directors for expenses incurred in
27 attending in-service workshops, conferences, and other courses of training
28 and instruction required in completing ~~a minimum of six (6) hours~~ the
29 training and ~~of~~ instruction as required in subsection (a) of this section.

30 (c)(1) The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules, which may
31 be included in the Standards for Accreditation of Arkansas Public Schools,
32 requiring that a statement of the hours of training and instruction obtained
33 by each board member in the preceding year be:

34 (A) Part of the comprehensive school plan and goals;

35 (B) Published in the same way that other components of the
36 comprehensive school plan and goals are required to be published; and

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
