1	(a) On and after January 1, 2006, sales of motor vehicles at a salvage
2	auction in the State of Arkansas shall be open only to persons who possess an
3	Arkansas salvage auction buyer's identification card issued under this
4	section.
5	(b)(l)(A) The salvage auction buyer's identification card authorizing
6	persons to bid or buy motor vehicles at a salvage auction shall be available
7	to any person, business, or corporation, or an employee thereof, that:
8	(i) Possesses a valid new motor vehicle dealer
9	license under § 23-112-301, a used motor vehicle dealer license under § 23-
10	112-607, a valid wrecker license under § 27-14-2001, or is a licensed motor
11	vehicle dealer from another state under § 23-112-615; and
12	(ii) Registers with the Department of Arkansas State
13	Police.
14	(B) Salvage auction buyer's identification cards shall be
15	issued by the Department of Arkansas State Police on a form prescribed by the

2	privilege to a dealer licensed in Arkansas and if the out-of-state motor
3	vehicle dealer obtains a salvage auction buyer's identification card as
4	required in § 23-112-613.
