16 AN ACT FOR THE OFFICE OF INFORMATION
17 TECHNOLOGY - AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHY,
18 CENTERLINE FILE AND ARKANSAS E-CORRIDOR
19 PROGRAMS APPROPRIATION.
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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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24 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS - INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY PROGRAMS. There is
25 hereby appropriated, to the Office of Information Technology, to be payable
26 from the *General Improvement Fund, or its successor fund or fund accounts,*
27 the following:

- 28 (A) For the Aerial Photography Program, the sum of\$1,000,000.
- 29 (B) For the Centerline File Program, the sum of.....\$750,000.
- 30 (C) For the Arkansas E-Corridor Program, the sum of\$10,000,000.

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32 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
33 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
34 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
35 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and



1 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
2 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
3 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
4 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
5 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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7 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
8 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
9 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
10 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
11 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
12 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
13 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
14 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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16 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
17 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
18 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
19 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
20 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
21 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
22 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
23 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
24 Therefore and emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
25 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
26 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
