19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-9-109 is amended to read as
22 follows:

23 7-9-109. Form of verification - Penalty for false statement.

24 (a) Each petition containing the signatures shall be verified in
25 substantially the following form, by the person who circulated the sheet of
26 the petition by his or her affidavit thereon as a part thereof:

27 "State of Arkansas)

29 I, _____, being first duly sworn, state that the foregoing
30 persons signed this sheet of the foregoing petition, and each of them signed
31 his or her name thereunto in my presence. I believe that each has stated his
32 or her name, date of birth, residence or town of residence correctly, and
33 that each signer is a legal voter of the State of Arkansas, _____
34 County, or City or Incorporated Town of _____.

8 (b) Forms herein given are not mandatory, and if substantially
9 followed in any petition it shall be sufficient, disregarding clerical and
10 merely technical errors.

11 (c)(1) Petitions shall not be disqualified due to clerical or
12 technical errors made by a clerk, notary, judge, or justice of the peace when
13 verifying the canvasser's signature.

14 (2) Petitions shall not be disqualified for failure of a clerk,
15 notary, judge, or justice of the peace to sign exactly as his or her name
16 appears on his or her seal if the signature of a clerk, notary, judge, or
17 justice of the peace is sufficient to verify his or her name.

18 ~~(e)~~(d) A canvasser who knowingly makes a false statement on a petition
19 verification form required by this section shall be deemed guilty of a Class
20 D felony.
