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17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-703 is amended to read as follows:  
20 6-17-703. Arkansas history in-service training.

21 (a) Every public school district in this state shall provide two (2)  
22 hours of substantive and meaningful in-service training in Arkansas history  
23 each school year for its teachers who provide instruction in Arkansas  
24 history.

25 (b) The district may contract with an education service cooperative to  
26 provide the training.

27 (c) The in-service training under this section shall count toward  
28 satisfaction of requirements for professional development in the Standards  
29 for Accreditation of Arkansas Public Schools.
