29	of 1979, § 15-58-101 et seq.; or
30	(B)(i) Mine, extract, or remove any other mineral or

Arkansas Code § 5-71-215(a), concerning defacing of objects 35 of public respect, is amended to read as follows:

(a) A person commits the offense of defacing objects of public respect

3	(2) Defaces, mars, or otherwise damages a work of art on display
4	in any public place; or
5	(3) Defaces, mars, desecrates, or otherwise damages any place of

7	(4) Removes broken or unbroken, commercial or rock grave markers
8	for any reason except for cleaning or repair by a family member, caretaker,
9	or preservation organization.

11	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 13-6-408(c), concerning desecration of
12	burial grounds and burial furniture, is amended to read as follows:
13	(c) Exempted from this section is disturbance of human skeletal burial
14	remains or burial furniture by landowners or agricultural tenants as a
15	consequence of agricultural activity or any other activity unless the
16	landowner or agricultural tenant knowingly desecrates or knowingly allows
17	desecration of a cemetery or burial site.
