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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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21 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 16, Subchapter 1 is amended*  
22 *to add an additional section to read as follows:*

23 *6-16-137. Technology curriculum.*

24 *(a) In order to prepare public school students in the State of*  
25 *Arkansas for successful participation in a growing knowledge-based economy*  
26 *and technology-rich world and to improve student achievement, the public*  
27 *school curriculum must integrate technology into the educational process.*

28 *(b)(1) In order to further the intent of this section, the Arkansas*  
29 *Science and Technology Authority shall develop a knowledge-based technology*  
30 *curriculum for use in grades seven through twelve (7-12). The curriculum*  
31 *shall be organized into a scope and sequence that constitutes a plan for*  
32 *achieving the educational objectives necessary for an adequate education as*  
33 *described in § 6-20-2302 and shall include the following components for each*  
34 *course in the curriculum:*

35 *(A) A collection of the substantive material used to teach*



1 a particular subject matter;  
2 (B) Lesson plans; and  
3 (C) Recommendations for activities and other learning  
4 processes.  
5 (2) The curriculum shall be developed in sufficient time to  
6 allow for implementation in the 2007-2008 school year.
