17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
18

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 17, Chapter 28, Subchapter 3 is amended  
20 to add an additional section to read as follows:

21 17-28-311. Continuing education requirement.

22 (a) No journeyman electrician license or master electrician license  
23 shall be renewed unless the licensee completes at least eight (8) hours of  
24 continuing education for each National Electric Code cycle.

25 (b)(1) The Board of Electrical Examiners of the State of Arkansas  
26 shall promulgate rules to set standards for continuing education for  
27 licensees under this section.

28 (2) The rules shall include, but not be limited to, provisions  
29 of the National Electrical Code, as in effect on January 1, 2005.
