34	this act will provide needed personnel to the prosecuting attorney of the		
35	Third Judicial District; and that this act is immediately necessary because		
36	the additional personnel are critical to the effort to combat crime in the		

1	Third Judicial District. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and		
2	this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public		
3	peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:		
4	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
5	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
