18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
19

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-13-211 is amended to read as follows:
21 20-13-211. Fees.

22 The State Board of Health may establish the fees to be charged by the
23 Department of Health which are deemed necessary to defray the cost of
24 administering and enforcing the provisions of this subchapter, as follows:

25 (1) The testing fee not to exceed the cost of administering the
26 Emergency Medical Technician National Registry Examination;

27 (2) The certification fee for emergency medical technicians,
28 which shall not exceed ~~ten dollars (\$10.00)~~ twenty dollars (\$20.00). Ten
29 dollars (\$10.00) of the certification fee shall be credited to the Emergency
30 Medical Services Revolving Fund, § 20-13-101. The certification shall be
31 valid for two (2) years;

32 (3) The biennial renewal of the emergency medical technician
33 certification, which shall not exceed ~~ten dollars (\$10.00)~~ twenty dollars
34 (\$20.00). Ten dollars (\$10.00) of the biennial renewal shall be credited to
35 the Emergency Medical Services Revolving Fund, § 20-13-101;



1 (4) The issuance and annual renewal of an operational permit for
2 each ambulance service, which shall not exceed fifty dollars (\$50.00);

3 (5) The annual inspection and permitting of emergency vehicles,
4 which shall not exceed five dollars (\$5.00) per vehicle; and

5 (6) The issuance and renewal of an operational license for each
6 air ambulance service, which shall not exceed one hundred dollars (\$100).

8 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 20-13-101 is amended to read as follows:
9 20-13-101. Title.

10 (a) This section shall be known as the "Emergency Medical Services
11 Revolving Fund Act".

12 (b) There is established on the books of the Treasurer of State, the
13 Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be
14 designated the Emergency Medical Services Revolving Fund.

15 (c)(1) It shall be the responsibility of the Office of Emergency
16 Medical Services to promulgate all rules and regulations for making
17 application for the matching funds.

18 (2) It shall be further the responsibility of the office to
19 review all applications and approve those that shall be eligible for moneys
20 under the provisions of this section and as may otherwise be provided by law.

21 (d)(1) Funds requested by authority of this section shall be matched
22 on a fifty/fifty (50/50) cash basis by the applicant.

23 (2) The state portion shall at no time exceed ten thousand
24 dollars (\$10,000) per county, local, commercial, or nonprofit operation,
25 except that this limitation shall not apply when any county levies a motor
26 vehicle tax to finance ambulance services as authorized by § 26-78-101 et
27 seq.

28 (e) All moneys deposited into this fund pursuant to § 20-13-211 shall
29 be used by the Office of Emergency Medical Services for the following
30 purposes:

31 (1) Certification processing for emergency medical technicians;

32 (2) Travel expenses related to the onsite administration of
33 practical and written examinations of emergency medical technicians;

34 (3) Maintenance of the emergency medical technician
35 certification software program;

36 (4) Educational programs for emergency medical technicians;

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
