9 AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 8-7-802(a)
10 CONCERNING THE ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE FOR
11 UNDERGROUND AND ABOVEGROUND STORAGE TANKS; AND
12 FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

14 AN ACT TO AMEND THE ANNUAL REGISTRATION
15 FEE FOR UNDERGROUND AND ABOVEGROUND

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 8-7-802(a), concerning the powers and
23 duties of the Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission, is amended
24 to read as follows:

25 (a) The Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission shall have
26 the following powers and duties:

27 (1) To promulgate, after notice and public hearing, and to
28 modify, repeal, and enforce, as necessary or appropriate to implement or
29 effectuate the purposes and intent of this subchapter, rules and regulations
30 relating to an underground storage tank release detection, prevention,
31 corrective action, and financial responsibility program as required by the
32 federal Resource Conservation and Recovery Act of 1976; and

33 (2)(A) To set reasonable fees for licensure of individuals and
34 annual registration of underground storage tanks and aboveground storage
35 tanks by rule or regulation.



1 (B) The annual registration fee for underground storage
2 tanks shall not exceed ~~fifty dollars (\$50.00)~~ seventy-five dollars (\$75.00)
3 per tank. The fee shall be used by the Arkansas Department of Environmental
4 Quality for administrative and program costs.

5 (C)(i) The annual registration fee for aboveground storage
6 tanks shall not exceed ~~fifty dollars (\$50.00)~~ seventy-five dollars (\$75.00)
7 per tank.

8 (ii) The fee shall be used by the Arkansas
9 Department of Environmental Quality for administrative and program costs, and
10 ten dollars (\$10.00) of ~~said~~ the fee collected by the Arkansas Department of
11 Environmental Quality shall be remitted to the State Treasury, there to be
12 deposited as special revenues to the credit of the Department of Arkansas
13 State Police Fund to be used for the purposes of aboveground storage tank
14 monitoring and regulation by the Department of Arkansas State Police.
