## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO ENSURE THE LICENSING AND REGISTRATION  
OF RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS, DEVICES CONTAINING  
RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL, AND X-RAY DEVICES; TO  
OFFSET COSTS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH; AND FOR  
OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO ENSURE THE FINANCIAL VIABILITY OF THE  
RADIATION CONTROL PROGRAM OF THE  
DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-21-217(b), concerning fees for the  
24 radiation control program of the Department of Health, is amended to read as  
25 follows:
