10 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE OPERATION ENDURING
11 FREEDOM VETERAN LICENSE PLATE; AND FOR OTHER
12 PURPOSES.

15 FREEDOM VETERAN LICENSE PLATE.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 27, Chapter 15 is amended to add an
22 additional subchapter to read as follows:

Subchapter 48.

Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran License Plate.

25 27-15-4801. Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran license plate
26 authorized.

27 The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration shall
28 issue a special Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran motor vehicle license
29 plate in the manner and subject to the conditions prescribed in this
30 subchapter.

27-15-4802. Design.

33 (a) The license plates issued under this subchapter shall be the
34 standard color and design as are currently issued by the Department of
35 Finance and Administration, except that in lieu of the legend "The Natural



1 State” or any succeeding legend, the license plates shall have placed across
2 the bottom a permanent decal bearing the words "Operation Enduring Freedom
3 Veteran”.

4 (b) The license plates issued under this subchapter shall be numbered
5 consecutively.

6
7 27-15-4803. Eligibility.

8 (a) The Department of Finance and Administration shall require proof
9 of eligibility for a special license plate under this subchapter.

10 (b) The proof shall be sufficient to establish that the applicant
11 honorably served in Operation Enduring Freedom.

12
13 27-15-4804.

14 (a) Upon payment of the fee required by law for the registration of
15 the vehicle and payment of an additional handling and administrative fee of
16 ten dollars (\$10.00) for the issuance of the special Operation Enduring
17 Freedom Veteran license plate, the Department of Finance and Administration
18 shall issue to the vehicle owner an Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran
19 license plate.

20 (b)(1) The handling and administrative fee of ten dollars (\$10.00)
21 shall be deposited to the State Central Services Fund for the benefit of the
22 Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and Administration.

23 (2) The fee shall not be considered or credited to the division
24 as direct revenues.

25
26 27-15-4805. Renewal.

27 (a)(1) The special Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran license plate
28 issued under this subchapter may be renewed annually under the procedures in
29 § 27-15-4803 and under §§ 27-14-1012 and 27-14-1013.

30 (2) Registration may continue from year to year as long as it is
31 renewed each year within the time and manner required by law.

32 (b) Upon expiration or if the special Operation Enduring Freedom
33 Veteran license plate is lost, the plate may be replaced with a regular
34 license plate at the fee specified in § 27-14-602(b)(6).

35 (c) If the special Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran license plate is
36 replaced with a new Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran license plate, the

1 owner shall be required to pay the fees for the issuance of the license plate
 2 under § 27-15-4803.

3
 4 27-15-4806. Transfer to another vehicle.

5 The special Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran license plate issued
 6 under this subchapter may be transferred from one (1) vehicle to another as
 7 provided in § 27-14-914.

8
 9 27-15-4807. Compliance with other laws -- Exemption from minimum
 10 applications and discontinuation.

11 (a) The special Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran license plate shall
 12 comply with all other state motor vehicle laws relating to registration and
 13 licensing of motor vehicles unless specifically provided otherwise in this
 14 subchapter.

15 (b) The special Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran license plate is
 16 exempt from the minimum application requirements under § 27-15-4004(a) and
 17 the discontinuation of the license plate under § 27-15-4004(b).

18
 19 27-15-4808. Rules and regulations.

20 The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration shall
 21 promulgate reasonable rules and regulations and prescribe forms as the
 22 director determines to be necessary for effectively and efficiently carrying
 23 out the intent and purposes of this subchapter.

24
 25 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
 26 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that since September 11, 2001, the
 27 country has an increased need for soldiers to fight against terrorism abroad;
 28 that Reservists and National Guard members risk their lives to protect and
 29 defend our country; that military service in Operation Enduring Freedom
 30 should be honored; and that this act is immediately necessary to honor the
 31 veterans of Operation Enduring Freedom. Therefore, an emergency is declared
 32 to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the
 33 public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:

34 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

35 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
 36 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the

1 bill; or

2 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
3 overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
