25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-29-112 is amended to read as follows:
28 12-29-112. Discharge or release.

29 (a) Inmates released upon completion of their term or released on
30 parole shall be supplied with satisfactory clothing and a travel subsidy as
31 prescribed by the Board of Corrections.

32 (b) Upon release of any inmate from any unit or center of the
33 Department of Correction, the department shall provide transportation for the
34 inmate to the closest commercial transportation pick-up point.

35 (c) Before the release of an inmate from any unit or center of the



1 department, the department shall provide:

2 (1) Testing or screening of the inmate for human

3 immunodeficiency virus (HIV); and

4 (2) Counseling regarding treatment options if the inmate tests

5 positive for human immunodeficiency virus (HIV).
