27	of $\frac{1}{1}$ one hundred twenty (120) days except by or with the consent of		
28	the governing body of the political subdivision.		
29	(3) Any order or proclamation declaring, continuing, or		
30	terminating a local disaster emergency shall be given prompt and general		
31	publicity and shall be filed promptly with the city or county clerk, as		
32	applicable.
