17 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS HOUSE OF
18 REPRESENTATIVES SUPPLEMENTAL
19 APPROPRIATION.
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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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25 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - SUPPLEMENTAL. There is hereby appropriated, to
26 the Arkansas House of Representatives, to be payable from the Constitutional
27 Officers Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas
28 House of Representatives which shall be supplemental and in addition to those
29 funds appropriated in Section 1 of Act 2 of 2007 and Section 11 of Act 308 of
30 2007, for the remainder of the biennial period ending June 30, 2009, the sum
31 of.....\$50,000.
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33 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
34 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
35 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the



1 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 2 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 3 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 4 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 5 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 6 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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 8 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
 9 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
 10 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
 11 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
 12 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
 13 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
 14 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
 15 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 17 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
 18 Assembly, meeting in extraordinary session, that funds provided by the
 19 General Assembly for the operations of the Arkansas House of Representatives
 20 are, due to the call of the Governor for convening of an extraordinary
 21 session, insufficient for the Arkansas House of Representatives to continue
 22 to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act
 23 will provide the necessary monies for the Arkansas House of Representatives
 24 to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act
 25 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of
 26 essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared
 27 to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the
 28 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and
 29 after the date of its passage and approval. If the bill is neither approved
 30 nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of
 31 the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill
 32 is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become
 33 effective on the date the last house overrides the veto.
