## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 AN ACT TO REVISE THE UNIFORM REAL PROPERTY ELECTRONIC  
9 RECORDING ACT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

11 TO REGULATE THE ELECTRONIC RECORDING LAW.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
17

18 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-2-305(a), concerning the composition of  
19 the Electronic Recording Commission, is amended to add an additional  
20 subdivision to read as follows:

21 14-2-305. Administration and standards.

22 (a)(1) An Electronic Recording Commission consisting of ~~nine (9)~~  
23 eleven (11) members appointed by the Governor is created to adopt standards  
24 to implement this subchapter.

25 (2) A majority of the members of the commission must be county  
26 recorders.

27 (3) A member of the commission must be an active state  
28 legislator.

29 ~~(3)~~(4) A member of the commission shall serve a term of two (2)  
30 years.

31 ~~(4)~~(5) The terms of the current commission members on July 31,  
32 2009 shall expire on September 1, 2009.

33 ~~(5)~~(6) Each member of the commission may receive expense  
34 reimbursement in accordance with § 25-16-901 et seq.

36 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 14-2-305, concerning assigning the Bureau



1 of Legislative Research to assist in administering the Uniform Real Property  
2 Electronic Recording Act, is amended to add an additional subsection to read  
3 as follows:

4 (c) A staff member of the Bureau of Legislative Research will be  
5 assigned to assist the Electronic Recording Commission. The staff member  
6 will coordinate meetings, accumulate information, and provide general support  
7 to the commission.
