20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-21-102 is amended to read as follows:
23 27-21-102. Definitions.

24 As used in this chapter:

25 (1)(A) "All-terrain vehicle" means a vehicle that:

26 (i) every three wheeled, four wheeled, or six-
27 wheeled vehicle Has three (3), four (4), or (6) wheels;

28 (ii) seventy five (75") Is fifty inches (50") or
29 less in width;

30 (iii) Is equipped with low pressure nonhighway
31 tires;

32 (iv) Is designed primarily for off-road recreational
33 use; and

34 (v) having Has an engine displacement of no more
35 than one thousand cubic centimeters (1,000 cc).

36 (B) "All-terrain vehicle" includes a recreational off-

2 (C) The term "all-terrain vehicle" shall not include any
3 "All-terrain vehicle" does not include a golf cart, riding lawnmower, or lawn
4 or garden tractor;

5 (2) "Low pressure tire" "Nonhighway tire" means a pneumatic
6 tire:

7 (A) ~~six~~ Six inches (6") or more in width;

8 (B) ~~designed~~ Designed for use on a wheel with a rim
9 diameter of ~~twelve inches (12")~~ fourteen inches (14") or less; and

10 (C) ~~utilizing~~ Using an operating pressure of ~~ten~~ twenty
11 pounds per square inch ~~(10 psi)~~ (20 psi) or less as recommended by the
12 vehicle manufacturer; and

13 (3) "Public streets and highways" means the part of the street,
14 road, or highway, including the improved road shoulder, ~~which~~ that is open to
15 vehicular traffic and ~~which~~ that is maintained by the state or by a political
16 subdivision of the State of Arkansas, and includes any federal highways; and

17 (4)(A) "Recreational off-highway vehicle" means a vehicle that:

18 (i) Has four (4) or six (6) wheels;

19 (ii) Is seventy-five inches (75") or less in width;

20 (iii) Is equipped with nonhighway tires;

21 (iv) Is designed primarily for off-road recreational
22 use; and

23 (v) Has an engine displacement of no more than one
24 thousand cubic centimeters (1,000 cc).

25 (B) "Recreational off-highway vehicle" does not include a
26 golf cart, riding lawnmower, or lawn or garden tractor.
