## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 AN ACT TO AMEND THE DEFINITION OF COLD WAR VETERAN  
9 UNDER THE SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE ACT OF 2005; TO  
10 CLARIFY THAT COLD WAR VETERANS CAN OBTAIN MULTIPLE  
11 LICENSE PLATES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

14 TO AMEND THE LAW REGARDING COLD WAR  
15 VETERAN SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20  
21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-24-1302 is amended to read as follows:  
22 27-24-1302. Definitions.

23 As used in this subchapter:

24 (1) "Cold War veteran" means any current or former member of the  
25 armed forces of the United States who ~~has received a Cold War Recognition~~  
26 ~~Certificate from the United States Secretary of Defense for~~ establishes  
27 service during the Cold War era from September 2, 1945 – December 26, 1991 by  
28 presenting his or her military service discharge record, the Certificate of  
29 Release or Discharge from Active Duty of the United States Department of  
30 Defense known as the DD Form 214;

31 (2) "Firefighter" means a person who is certified by the  
32 Arkansas Fire Protection Services Board as a certified firefighter or who has  
33 retired as a firefighter;

34 (3) "Professional firefighter" means a person who is in good  
35 standing with the Arkansas Professional Fire Fighters Association;

36 (4) "Public service" means a service provided by a city, a



1 county, or the state government that requires licensure or certification by  
2 the person who is providing the service; and

3 (5) "Retired state trooper" means a former employee of the  
4 Department of Arkansas State Police who is eligible for and is receiving  
5 retirement benefits related to the retiree's employment as a state trooper.

7 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-24-1312, regarding special license  
8 plates for Cold War veterans, is amended to add an additional subsection to  
9 read as follows:

10 (f) As long as the fee for the special license plate issued under this  
11 section is the fee required by law for the registration and licensing of the  
12 motor vehicle and not that for a nominal fee military service and veteran  
13 plate under § 27-24-201 et seq., a Cold War veteran may obtain multiple  
14 license plates, not to exceed the number of vehicles that he or she owns.
