22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
25 Department of Career Education - Arkansas Rehabilitation Services for the
26 2014-2015 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees.

20 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department
 21 of Career Education - Arkansas Rehabilitation Services for the 2014-2015
 22 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary
 23 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated
 24 herein for such purposes: nineteen (19) temporary or part-time employees,
 25 when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform
 26 Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the
 27 appropriate classification.

28

29 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
 30 to the Department of Career Education - Arkansas Rehabilitation Services, to
 31 be payable from the paying account as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer
 32 of the State, for personal services and operating expenses of the Department

34 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
 36 COMPREHENSIVE SYSTEM OF PERSONNEL DEVELOPMENT. Section 101(a)(7) of the

1 Rehabilitation Act Amendments of 1992, commonly referred to as the
2 Comprehensive System of Personnel Development (CSPD), requires State
3 Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) agencies to establish qualified personnel
4 standards for rehabilitation personnel, including VR counselors, that are
5 consistent with any national or State-approved or recognized certification,
6 licensing, or registration that apply to a particular profession. In order to
7 comply with the Rehabilitation Act and its State Plan requirements, there is
8 hereby authorized for the Department of Career Education-Arkansas
9 Rehabilitation Services a general waiver of the Financial Management Guide,
10 R1-19-4-522 Continuing Professional Education. This waiver allows the agency
11 to provide college level coursework in degree programs for any eligible
12 employees selected by the agency. This provision covers any and all formula
13 and discretionary grants funded by the U.S.D.O.E. Rehabilitation Services
14 Administration, now or in the future, including, but not limited to, the
15 Vocational Rehabilitation Program, Supported Employment, Independent Living,
16 and the Staff Development Grant. The waiver applies to federal financial
17 participation (FFP), state general revenue share, and program income.

18 The provisions of this section shall be in effect from July 1, ~~2012~~ 2014
19 through June 30, ~~2013~~ 2015.

20
21 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

23 FORGIVENESS OF STUDENT LOAN PROGRAM. The Forgiveness of Student Loan Program
24 shall be available to counselors employed by Arkansas Rehabilitation Services
25 that have been determined eligible by rules promulgated by Arkansas
26 Rehabilitation Services as required by Arkansas Code §25-30-206. These rules
27 shall be submitted to the Administrative Rules and Regulations Subcommittee
28 of the Arkansas Legislative Council and receive prior review. These rules
29 must include the following eligibility requirements:

30 (1) Satisfactory completion of any probationary period;

31 (2) Proof of a student loan that remains unpaid, including the name and
32 address of the creditor;

33 (3) An executed employment contract in which the counselor agrees to
34 the following:

35 (a) work for Arkansas Rehabilitation Services for a term that equals
36 two (2) years for each year that the program makes a payment on the

1 counselor's student loan and

2 (b) reimburse the program the full amount of any loan payments made
3 under this program in the event that the counselor resigns or is terminated
4 for cause before the term of the contract terminates.

5 The amount of payment to be made directly to the counselor's student
6 loan creditor may not exceed:

7 (1) Two thousand dollars (\$2,000) per year; or

8 (2) Ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) per employee.

9 The Arkansas Rehabilitation Services agency shall pay for the
10 Forgiveness of Student Loan Program from the Rehabilitation Program Grants -
11 Grants and Aid line item authorized for the appropriation entitled
12 Rehabilitation Services - Operations in an amount not to exceed eighty
13 thousand dollars (\$80,000) per fiscal year.

14 In addition, the Arkansas Rehabilitation Services agency shall provide a
15 formal, written notification to all counselors employed by Arkansas
16 Rehabilitation Services of the availability of the Forgiveness of Student
17 Loan Program by July 1 of each fiscal year. The agency shall include with the
18 notification, the promulgated rules which shall outline the eligibility
19 requirements for participation.

20 The agency shall submit a copy of this notification to the Arkansas
21 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee by July 1 of each fiscal year.
22 In addition, Arkansas Rehabilitation Services shall report bi-annually, by
23 the 15th day of the month following the end of each six month period, to the
24 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee the number of
25 employees participating in the program.

26

27 SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
28 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
29 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
30 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
31 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
32 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
33 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
34 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
35 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

36

1 SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
2 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
3 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
4 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
5 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
6 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
7 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
8 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

9
10 SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
11 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
12 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
13 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2014 is essential to the operation of
14 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
15 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
16 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2014 could work irreparable harm
17 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
18 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
19 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
20 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2014.
