13 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF RURAL
14 SERVICES REAPPROPRIATION.
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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20 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby
21 appropriated, to the Department of Rural Services, to be payable from the
22 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the
23 Department of Rural Services the following:

24 (A) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
25 in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 953 of 2013, for grants to enhance recycling
26 efforts in rural areas, in a sum not to exceed.....\$10,857.

27 (B) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
28 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 953 of 2013, for grants to counties,
29 municipalities, or subdivisions thereof, or other eligible entities for
30 operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and maintenance
31 expenses for African American cemeteries, in a sum not to exceed
32\$9,857.

33 (C) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
34 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 259 of 2013, for grants to fire departments,
35 counties, municipalities, or subdivisions thereof, or other eligible entities
36 for operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and



1 maintenance expenses associated with public buildings, community centers,
2 memorials, parks, amphitheaters, recreation centers, fire protection and
3 cemeteries, in a sum not to exceed.....\$5,000,000.

4 (D) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
5 in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 648 of 2013, for community improvement grants to
6 counties, for operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation,
7 and maintenance expenses associated with county fairs, in a sum not to exceed
8\$250,000.

9 (E) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
10 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 648 of 2013, for grants to fire departments,
11 counties, municipalities, or subdivisions thereof, or other eligible entities
12 for operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and
13 maintenance expenses associated with public buildings, community centers,
14 memorials, parks, amphitheaters, recreation centers, public libraries, fire
15 protection and cemeteries, in a sum not to exceed.....\$250,000.

16 (F) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
17 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 651 of 2013, for grants to fire departments,
18 counties, municipalities, or subdivisions thereof, or other eligible entities
19 for operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and
20 maintenance expenses associated with public buildings, community centers,
21 memorials, parks, amphitheaters, recreation centers, fire protection and
22 cemeteries, in a sum not to exceed.....\$750,000.

23 (G) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
24 in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 651 of 2013, for grants to counties for
25 operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and maintenance
26 expenses associated with sheriff departments, in a sum not to exceed
27\$750,000.

28 (H) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
29 in Item (C) Section 1 of Act 651 of 2013, for community improvement grants to
30 counties, for operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation,
31 and maintenance expenses associated with county fairs and 4-H organizations,
32 in a sum not to exceed.....\$750,000.

33 (I) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
34 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 813 of 2013, for community improvement grants to
35 counties, for operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation,
36 and maintenance expenses associated with county fairs and rodeos, in a sum

1 not to exceed.....\$1,000,000.

2 (J) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
3 in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 813 of 2013, for grants to Arkansas' Boys and
4 Girls Clubs for operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation,
5 and maintenance expenses associated with providing youth program activities,
6 in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,000,000.

7 (K) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
8 in Item (C) Section 1 of Act 813 of 2013, for grants to fire departments,
9 counties, municipalities, or subdivisions thereof, or other eligible entities
10 for operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and
11 maintenance expenses associated with public buildings, community centers,
12 memorials, parks, amphitheaters, recreation centers, fire protection and

18 (M) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
19 in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 664 of 2013, for grants to fire departments,
20 counties, municipalities, or subdivisions thereof, or other eligible entities
21 for operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and
22 maintenance expenses associated with public buildings, community centers,
23 memorials, parks, amphitheaters, recreation centers, fire protection and
24 cemeteries, in a sum not to exceed.....\$400,000.

25 (N) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
26 in Item (C) Section 1 of Act 664 of 2013, for grants to counties,
27 municipalities, or subdivisions thereof, or other eligible entities for
28 operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and maintenance
29 expenses for African American cemeteries, in a sum not to exceed
30\$400,000.

31 (O) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
32 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 345 of 2013, for grants to Arkansas' Boys and
33 Girls Clubs for operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation,
34 and maintenance expenses associated with providing youth program activities,
35 in a sum not to exceed.....\$250,000.

36 (P) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided

1 in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 345 of 2013, for grants to fire departments,
2 counties, municipalities, or subdivisions thereof, or other eligible entities
3 for operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and
4 maintenance expenses associated with public buildings, community centers,
5 memorials, parks, amphitheaters, recreation centers, fire protection and
6 cemeteries, in a sum not to exceed.....\$500,000.

34 (V) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided

12 (X) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
13 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 917 of 2013, for grants to counties for
14 operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and maintenance
15 expenses associated with county jails, in a sum not to exceed
16\$1,000,000.

17 (Y) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
18 in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 917 of 2013, for grants to fire departments,
19 counties, municipalities, or subdivisions thereof, or other eligible entities
20 for operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and
21 maintenance expenses associated with public buildings, community centers,
22 memorials, parks, amphitheaters, recreation centers, fire protection and
23 cemeteries, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,000,000.

24 (Z) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
25 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 366 of 2013, for grants to fire departments,
26 counties, municipalities, or subdivisions thereof, or other eligible entities
27 for operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and
28 maintenance expenses associated with public buildings, community centers,
29 memorials, parks, amphitheaters, recreation centers, fire protection and
30 cemeteries, in a sum not to exceed.....\$500,000.

31 (AA) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
32 in Item (A) Section 2 of Act 802 of 2013, for grants to fire departments,
33 counties, municipalities, or subdivisions thereof, or other eligible entities
34 for operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and
35 maintenance expenses associated with public buildings, community centers,
36 memorials, parks, amphitheaters, recreation centers, fire protection and

1 cemeteries, in a sum not to exceed.....\$250,000.

2 (BB) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
 3 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 807 of 2013, for grants to fire departments,
 4 counties, municipalities, or subdivisions thereof, or other eligible entities
 5 for operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and
 6 maintenance expenses associated with public buildings, community centers,
 7 memorials, parks, amphitheaters, recreation centers, fire protection and
 8 cemeteries, in a sum not to exceed.....\$200,000.

9 (CC) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
 10 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 389 of 2013, for grants to fire departments,
 11 counties, municipalities, or subdivisions thereof, or other eligible entities
 12 for operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and
 13 maintenance expenses associated with public buildings, community centers,
 14 memorials, parks, amphitheaters, 2recreation centers, fire protection and
 15 cemeteries, in a sum not to exceed.....\$500,000.

16 (DD) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
 17 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 812 of 2013, for grants to fire departments,
 18 counties, municipalities, or subdivisions thereof, or other eligible entities
 19 for operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and
 20 maintenance expenses associated with public buildings, community centers,
 21 memorials, parks, amphitheaters, recreation centers, fire protection and
 22 cemeteries, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,000,000.

23 (EE) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
 24 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 398 of 2013, for grants to fire departments,
 25 counties, municipalities, or subdivisions thereof, or other eligible entities
 26 for operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and
 27 maintenance expenses associated with public buildings, community centers,
 28 memorials, parks, amphitheaters, recreation centers, fire protection and
 29 cemeteries, in a sum not to exceed.....\$250,000.

30 (FF) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
 31 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 634 of 2013, for grants to fire departments,
 32 counties, municipalities, or subdivisions thereof, or other eligible entities
 33 for operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and
 34 maintenance expenses associated with public buildings, community centers,
 35 memorials, parks, amphitheaters, recreation centers, fire protection and
 36 cemeteries, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,000,000.

1 (GG) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
 2 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 851 of 2013, for grants to fire departments,
 3 counties, municipalities, or subdivisions thereof, or other eligible entities
 4 for operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and
 5 maintenance expenses associated with public buildings, community centers,
 6 memorials, parks, amphitheaters, recreation centers, fire protection and
 7 cemeteries, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,000,000.

8 (HH) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
 9 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 860 of 2013, for grants to fire departments,
 10 counties, municipalities, or subdivisions thereof, or other eligible entities
 11 for operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and
 12 maintenance expenses associated with public buildings, community centers,
 13 memorials, parks, amphitheaters, recreation centers, fire protection and
 14 cemeteries, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,000,000.

15 (II) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
 16 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 868 of 2013, for grants to fire departments,
 17 counties, municipalities, or subdivisions thereof, or other eligible entities
 18 for operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and
 19 maintenance expenses associated with public buildings, community centers,
 20 memorials, parks, amphitheaters, recreation centers, fire protection and
 21 cemeteries, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,000,000.

22 (JJ) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
 23 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 399 of 2013, for grants to fire departments,
 24 counties, municipalities, or subdivisions thereof, or other eligible entities
 25 for operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and
 26 maintenance expenses associated with the provision of fire protection, search
 27 and rescue, emergency medical services and emergency management programs, in
 28 a sum not to exceed.....\$1,000,000.

29 (KK) Effective July 1, 2014, the balance of the appropriation provided
 30 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 835 of 2013, for grants to fire departments,
 31 counties, municipalities, or subdivisions thereof, or other eligible entities
 32 for operating, construction, improvements, equipment, renovation, and
 33 maintenance expenses associated with the provision of fire protection, search
 34 and rescue, emergency medical services and emergency management programs, in
 35 a sum not to exceed.....\$500,000.

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1 SECTION 2. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
2 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
3 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
4 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
5 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
6 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
7 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
8 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
9 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
10 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
11 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
12 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

13 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing
14 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
15 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
16 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,
17 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any
18 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.
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20 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
21 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
22 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
23 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
24 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
25 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
26 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
27 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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29 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
30 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
31 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
32 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2014 is essential to the operation of
33 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
34 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
35 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2014 could work irreparable harm
36 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental

1 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
2 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
3 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2014.
