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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
24 Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training for the 2014-
25 2015 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees.

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SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - ATTORNEY GENERAL FUNDING. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training, to be payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training, for repairs and upgrades to the ALETA firing range, equipment, building maintenance and repairs to the main complex and repairs to the NW ALETA in Springdale, Arkansas of the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training - Attorney General Funding for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, the following:

SECTION 6. APPROPRIATION - BENEFICIARIES OF FALLEN LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training, to be payable from the Fallen Law Enforcement Officers' Beneficiary Fund, for personal services, operating expenses and grants to provide support and assistance to beneficiaries of fallen law enforcement officers for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, the sum of\$25,000.

SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD. Any unexpended balances of funds authorized for Capital Outlay in Section 2 of this Act on June 30, ~~2013~~ 2015, shall be carried forward and made available for the same purpose during the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~2014~~ 2016.

Any carry forward of unexpended balance of funding as authorized herein, may be carried forward under the following conditions:

- (1) Prior to June 30, ~~2013~~ 2015, the Agency shall by written statement set forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;
- (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward from the first fiscal year of the biennium to the second fiscal year of the

1 biennium by the September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
2 Committee meeting in the second fiscal year of the biennial period which
3 report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution
4 and the amount of funding carried forward from the first fiscal year to the
5 second fiscal year, the program name or line item, the funding source and a
6 copy of the written request set forth in (1) above;

7 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written
8 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
9 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written
10 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for
11 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)
12 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents
13 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget
14 Committee; and

15 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include
16 all information obtained in item (3) above in the budget manuals and/or a
17 statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution.
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19 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
20 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
21 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
22 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
23 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
24 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
25 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
26 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
27 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.
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29 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
30 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
31 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
32 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
33 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
34 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
35 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
36 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2014 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2014 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2014.
