24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-85-203(c), concerning the applicability
27	of the Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship Program — Part 2, is amended
28	to read as follows:
29	(c)(1) Recipients of Arkansas Governor's Distinguished Scholarships
30	are prohibited from receiving Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarships <u>may</u>
31	receive an Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship under this subchapter.
32	(2) The amount of an Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship
33	awarded to a recipient of an Arkansas Governor's Distinguished Scholarship
34	shall not be more than the maximum scholarship amount provided to a recipien
35	of an Arkansas Governor's Distinguished Scholarship under § 6-82-312.

1 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-85-208(1), concerning additional 2 eligibility requirements for a nontraditional student under the Arkansas 3 Academic Challenge Scholarship Program Part - 2, is amended to read as 4 follows: 5 (1)(A) If the applicant has not been enrolled in an approved 6 institution of higher education, has either: 7 (A) Graduated from an Arkansas public high school and 8 achieved a 2.5 high school grade point average; or 9 (B)(i) Graduated graduated from an Arkansas public high 10 school, a private high school, an out-of-state high school, a home school 11 high school, or obtained a high school equivalency diploma approved by the 12 Adult Education Section and had a superscore of nineteen (19) on the ACT or 13 the equivalent score on an ACT equivalent. 14 (ii) (B) The Division of Higher Education shall 15 promulgate rules in consultation with ACT, Inc. to determine the mechanism 16 for calculating and disseminating an applicant's superscore on the ACT; or 17 18 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-85-216(a)(1) and (2), concerning reports 19 submitted to the Division of Higher Education by institutions of higher 20 education, are amended to read as follows: 21 (a)(1)(A) An approved institution of higher education that enrolls 22 students receiving scholarships under this subchapter annually shall provide 23 information and semiannually shall provide updated information to the 24 Division of Higher Education regarding all state-supported student financial 25 assistance, whether or not the state-supported student financial assistance 26 is awarded under this subchapter. 27 (B) An approved institution of higher education is not 28 required to provide the information described in subdivision (a)(1)(A) of 29 this section to the division if the information has previously been reported 30 to the division through the Arkansas Higher Education Information System or 31 the state financial aid information system. 32 The information described in subdivision (a)(1)(A) of this 33 section shall be provided in the form of individual student records and shall 34 include without limitation information regarding: 35 (A) State-supported student financial assistance The

criteria for determining eligibility for scholarships under this subchapter;

2	(C) Disaggregated data on remedial courses.

4	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 6-85-219(c), concerning reports that are
5	required to be submitted to legislative committees by the Division of Higher
6	Education, is amended to read as follows:
7	(c) Annually by December 31, the division shall report to the
8	Legislative Council the following information summary-level data, in
9	accordance with § 6-85-216, on recipients of the Arkansas Academic Challenge
10	Scholarship Program - Part 2 scholarships under this subchapter who applied
11	as of June 1:
12	(1) Race;
13	(2) Grade point average;
14	(3) Composite score on the ACT or the equivalent score on an ACT
15	equivalent; and
16	(4) Family or individual income as reported on the student's
17	Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
