17 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 18 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Tax Appeals Commission is scheduled to begin operations on January 1, 2023; that it is essential that 19 20 the commissioners of the commission be appointed and begin work as soon as 21 possible to prepare to begin operations in 2023; that the initial 22 commissioners of the commission are required to be appointed by July 1, 2022, 23 and the pool of candidates must be submitted to the Governor by December 31, 24 2021; and that this act is immediately necessary because it is essential that 25 the entities recommending pools of candidates to the Governor for the initial 26 appointment of commissioners to the commission have adequate notice of the 27 requirements for making recommendations to ensure the timely and effective operation of the commission. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, 28 29 and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public 30 peace, health, and safety shall become effective on: (1) The date of its approval by the Governor; 31 32 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, 33 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the 34 bill; or 35 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
