9 FOR THE ARKANSAS TECH UNIVERSITY WHICH SHALL BE

11 APPROPRIATED BY ACT 110 OF 2021; AND FOR OTHER

15 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS TECH UNIVERSITY
16 SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby
23 appropriated, to the Arkansas Tech University, to be payable from the
24 Arkansas Tech University Fund, for personal services of the Arkansas Tech
25 University which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds
26 appropriated in Section 3 of Act 110 of 2021, the following:

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32 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
33 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
34 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
35 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
36 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary



1 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
2 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
3 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
4 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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6 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
7 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
8 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
9 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
10 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
11 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
12 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
13 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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15 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
16 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of
17 the Arkansas Tech University are, due to unforeseen circumstances,
18 insufficient for the Arkansas Tech University to continue to provide
19 essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide
20 the necessary monies for the Arkansas Tech University to continue such
21 services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work
22 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential
23 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
24 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
25 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the
26 date of its passage and approval.

27 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall
28 become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the
29 Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the
30 veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house
31 overrides the veto.
